

NEW BOYS' BAND CONDUCTOR

Mr. L. D. O'Donnell has been appointed full-time conductor of the Launceston Boys' Band. He will commence duties on Thursday week.

Mr. O'Donnell, who plays the trumpet and piano, has been studying at the Melbourne University Conservatorium. He was a member of the Prahran City Band, and during the war was bandmaster in the 2/2nd Pioneer Battalion.

Speaking of his plans for the band, he said he hoped to present popular orchestral works. He was prepared to teach members of the band theory of music in the hope of making them musicians, distinct from bandmen.
