

LOST TWO SONS IN AMBOINA

Advice has been received by Mr and Mrs James Jackson, of Lang-Lang, of the deaths of their third son, Pte Stanley Arthur Jackson (Pompey), 2/21st Battalion, and of their youngest son, Douglas Kenyon Jackson,

2/21st Battalion, who are believed to have died at Laha, Amboina, while POW, about February 2, 1942.

Both were educated at the Lang Lang state school. On leaving school Stanley joined his father's bakery business, and remained until his enlistment in 1940. Douglas was employed as a butcher in Lang Lang.

Two other brothers, Alan (2/2nd Pioneers, AIF) and Ron, comprise the family.
